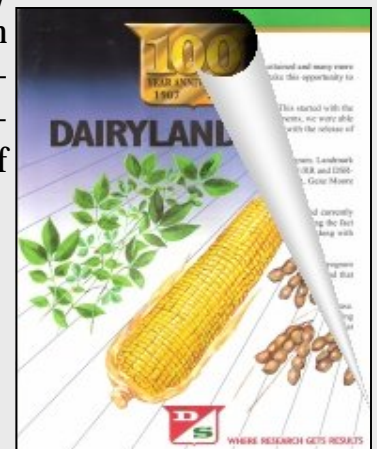

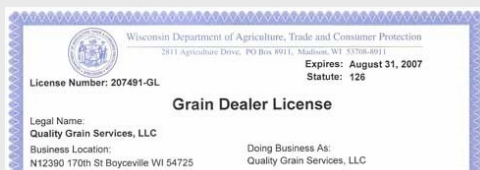

## *NEW LICENSES*



We have now become a state-licensed grain dealer, and also a state-licensed warehouse. QGS will also be a federal-licensed warehouse by the summer.

What this means for our customers is that you can now be reassured that we have the physical inventory on hand that we say in our records. The state will also conduct annual audits of our books and physical inventory.

We now have to pay into a fund which will guarantee that if something goes wrong on our end, you would still get paid for your grain.

The reason QGS applied for the federal warehouse license is to help out people who wish to put their grain under a CCC Loan. This will allow us to provide the grain receipt that you need to take to your local FSA office.

## *EXPANSION 2007*

This year will continue to bring growth and expansion to our facilities. As some of you may already know, we are trying to do some additional drying for people that want to bring their corn to the new ethanol plant, Western Wisconsin Energy. Last year, we offered free delivery from our facility to WWE. We are hoping to do something similar this year so people from farther away can afford to bring their grain to our location.

Because of this additional corn intake, QGS is planning on adding a larger dryer and

additional storage space.

The dryer is an exciting new system that is rated at 2,500 bu./hr. It is a tower dryer by MC, which will be 12 ft. in diameter and 80 ft. tall. It will dry much faster and quieter than our previous dryer. We will also have approximately 75,000 bu. of storage for wet corn.

Our team here at QGS is also planning on adding a storage bin that will hold 100,000 bu. of grain. This will give more flexibility to individuals who wish to sell their grain to WWE at a later date. We will

be more than willing to rent storage space to you until you are ready to sell.

We have been in the grain drying and storage business for 9 years. Our objective has always been to keep things moving as fast and as smoothly as possible during the harvest season.

# GRAIN PRICES

*Isn't it great? Especially if you still have some corn or beans to sell- The prices are really impressing me!*

*For those of you that are all sold out (like me), I hope you are looking at forward contracting this year's crop. As long as I have been farming, this opportunity has never occurred. You can now forward-contract corn above \$3.50/bu. for HARVEST time delivery! If you can wait until after the first of the year, you'll get twice the return on your storage and interest costs.*

*Even if you only get 100 bu./acre yield, you will still get \$350.00/acre gross. That should be profitable for almost everyone!*

*Please feel free to call for grain quotes. We've always done our best to offer competitive prices for both picked-up and delivered corn. We can also take care of your forward contracting needs.*

*If you still have beans to sell, prices have risen over \$1.50 since harvest! Give me a call when you are ready to sell! Harvest time prices are currently around \$7.50 for at harvest-time contracts.*

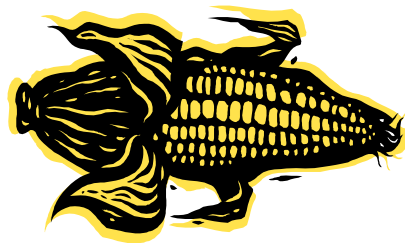
