LATEST QGS NEWS

All of the improvements and expansions that we made around the Quality Grain Services facility last summer have been implemented with great success. By the end of 2012's harvest season we dried approximately 1,765,000 bushels of corn and had more than 1,450,000 bushels of grain in inventory on site.

Last summer's project, the large grain bin, was finished as scheduled and proved to be an enormous improvement to the Quality Grain Services facility and to our workflow. The new bin was responsible for helping harvest move smoothly for the duration of the fall months.

Although we did not need to make a large pile of dry corn this year like

we have in the past, we were able to utilize a new storage technique for our overflow grain. For this season, we stored the corn and beans that didn't fit in our storage bins in bags. This new process worked really well. Bagging grain is a great way for us to expand our storage capacity without making large capital investments. Plus, the system allows us bag wet grain and avoid overworking the dryer during busy months and ensures that your waiting time is shorter.

As a result of our bagging success, we decided to purchase our own large grain bagger and grain bag unloader to use in the future. We are excited to continue using this technique and keep passing our savings on to you!

CONSTRUCTION UPDATES

As most of our customers know, we have been doing quite a bit of construction work and expansions around the facility over the last couple of years. However, this year we will be focusing on only one small expansion project.

We had some small issues with storage space for wet grain last harvest, so we will be enlarging our wet bin to remedy this. By adding


three rings to the bin we will add approximately 10,000 bushels of wet grain storage capacity to the facility. Hopefully, this will prevent wet grain overflows on busy harvest days and keep our lines moving.

While we do not have any large construction projects happening this summer, I am sure we will still be busy making sure all of our existing equipment is in top-notch working order and ready for next fall’s harvest.


Stay tuned to see what we are working on for next year, good luck with your spring planting, and stay safe!
